TECHNICAL UPDATES

We recently completed upgrading our group of servers that support our central station operations. While it sounds like a simple project, it was a hectic process for a couple of weeks making sure everything worked properly on the new hardware. This upgrade now allows us to pursue additional technical upgrades in the field to optimize our technicians level of information for each account.

We are continuing to migrate more accounts to our internet/cellular communicators that use both a local internet connection and a private cellular network connection to communicate data from alarm panels to our monitoring center without using phone lines. As traditional land line phone lines become increasingly expensive, and harder to obtain, the transition to internet/cellular communicators becomes more and more popular.

We are also completing upgrading our older 2G cellular communicators to newer units that are 3G/4G compatible. Apparently the cellular carriers are going to be phasing out 2G service early next year, and we hope to be completed with our upgrades by the end of November. We asked one of the technical guru's with Honeywell how long we could expect a given cellular technology to be good for, and his answer was that we should expect to upgrade any cellular technology at least every five years. Apparently change is the new normal!
